BRET PEPPO, vocal director

Bret Peppo is finishing his seventh year as Director of Choral Activities and Music Department chair at Diablo Valley College. He conducts the Concert Chorale, Chamber Singers Masterworks Chorale and the Vocal Jazz Ensembles. Prior to his appointment at DVC, Peppo was the Director of Choral Activities at Alderson-Broaddus College at the University of South Alabama and at Illinois State University. He also held the positions as director of the Old Gold Singers (show choir), at the University of Iowa.



His concert, show and jazz choirs have toured extensively throughout the country and have been selected to perform for the Alabama and Illinois All-State Conferences in 1998, 2002, 2003. As a conductor, Mr. Peppo has conducted many high school and collegiate all-state festivals for both honor choir as well as jazz choirs and is a frequent adjudicator and clinician with many national music festivals and is busy as a judge from show choir and vocal jazz competitions.

Bret Peppo earned a bachelors degree in Vocal Music Education from Eastern Illinois University, a Masters of Conducting at Illinois State University and is doctorate from the University of Iowa in Choral Conducting and Pedagogy.

DAVID LEGG, choreography

David Legg holds a Bachelors of Arts in Music Education from Liberty University as well as a Masters of Arts in Musical Theatre Performance from New York University. David taught in the public school system for eleven years where his choirs won numerous awards on both the state and national level.



During his time as an educator Mr. Legg instructed at the secondary and collegiate levels, received several honors for excellence in teaching and was the chairman of the West Virginia Music Educators State Show Choir Festival. David has choreographed and arranged music for many top-ranking show choirs throughout the United States. He currently lives in San Diego where he works as a music director, composer, arranger, choreographer, show consultant and choral clinician.

Mr. Legg has acted as the music director for productions presented by the Charleston Light Opera Guild, Liberty University, Fee/Hedrick Family Entertainment, Alluvion Stage Company and Norwegian Cruise Lines, as well as, composing the music for three original musicals performed in university and professional theaters. In his "free time", David can be found judging show choir contests. He has been on the judging panel for such prestigious contests as FAME Show Choir Festivals and Show Choir Nationals held at the Grand Ole Opry in Nashville, TN. Over the years he has been invited to adjudicate contests in thirteen states from the East to the West Coast.
